(Entering grades 2nd – 6th)

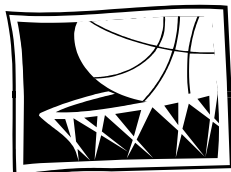
- Coach Jim Realer will return this summer to work on basketball fundamentals at the JCC!
